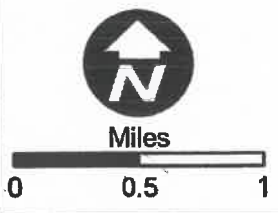
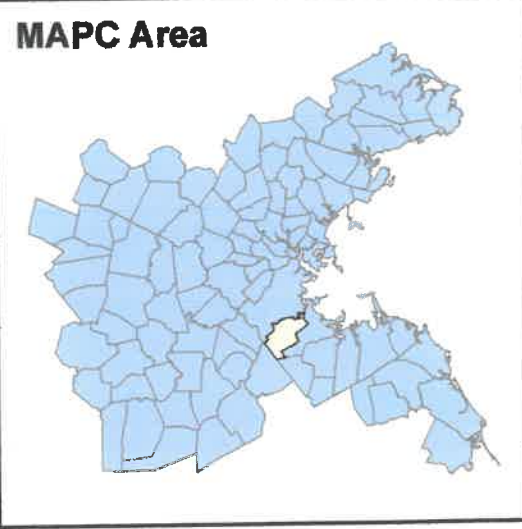
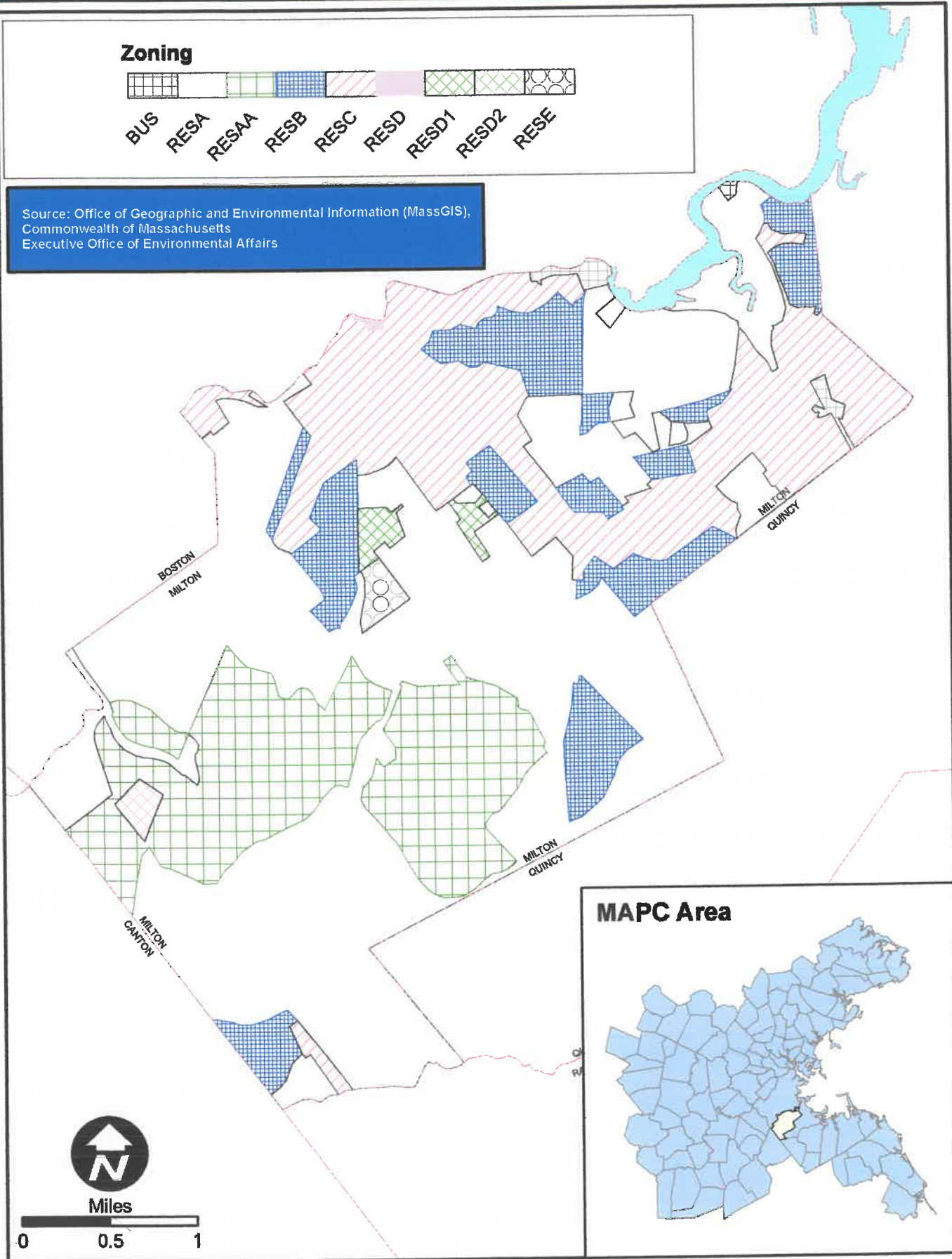


Map 1a: Zoning

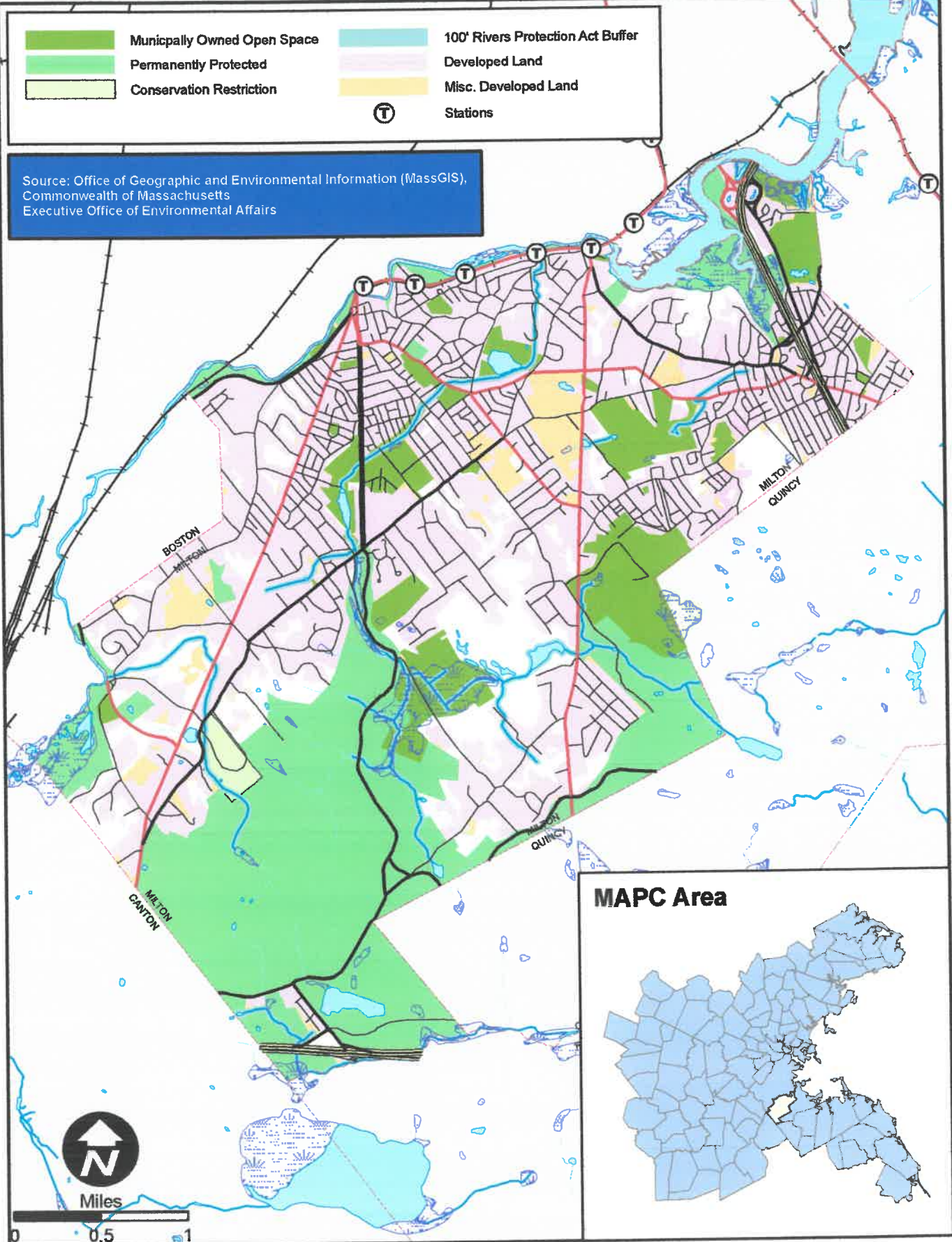

Map 1b: Growth & Development Patterns



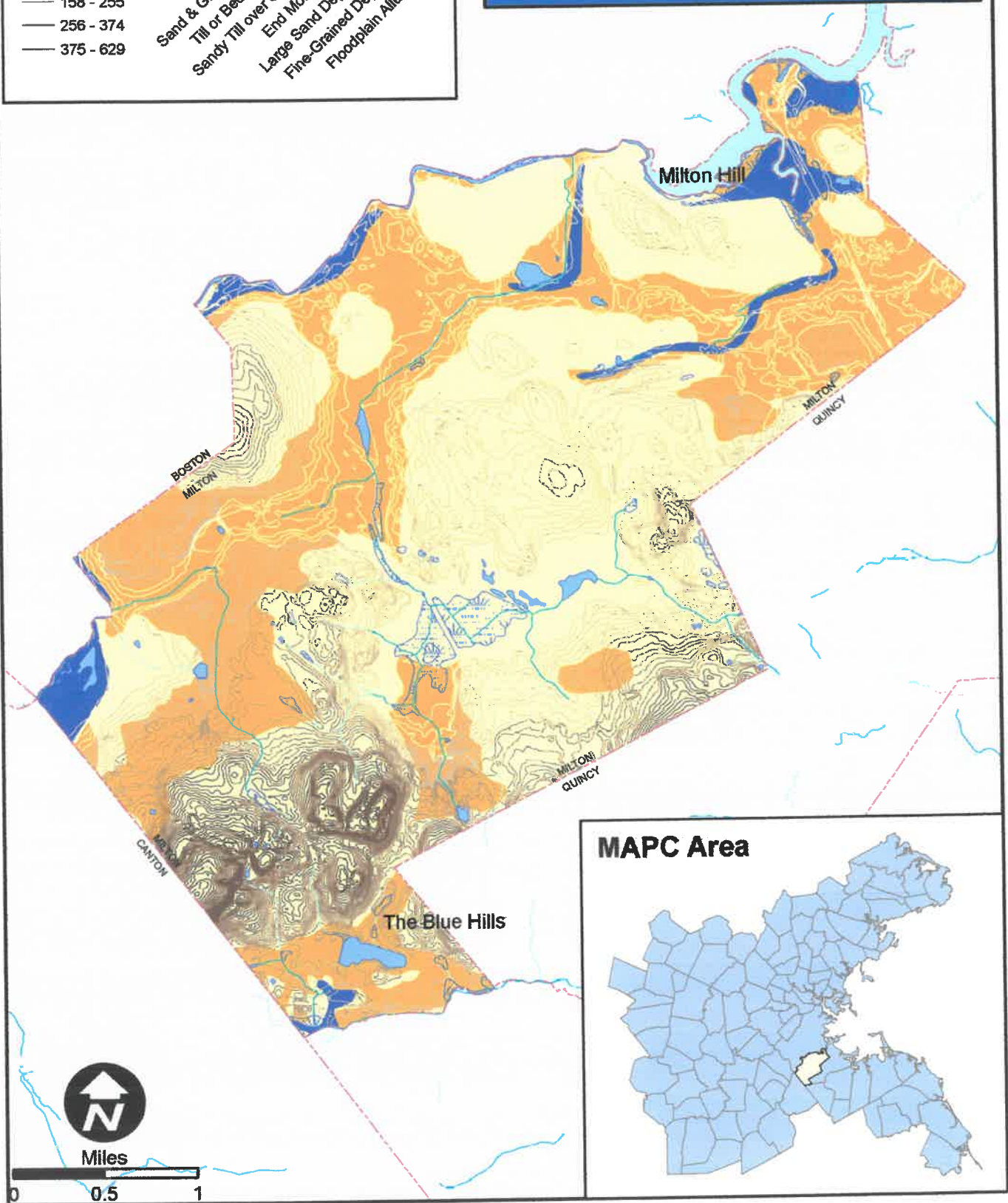

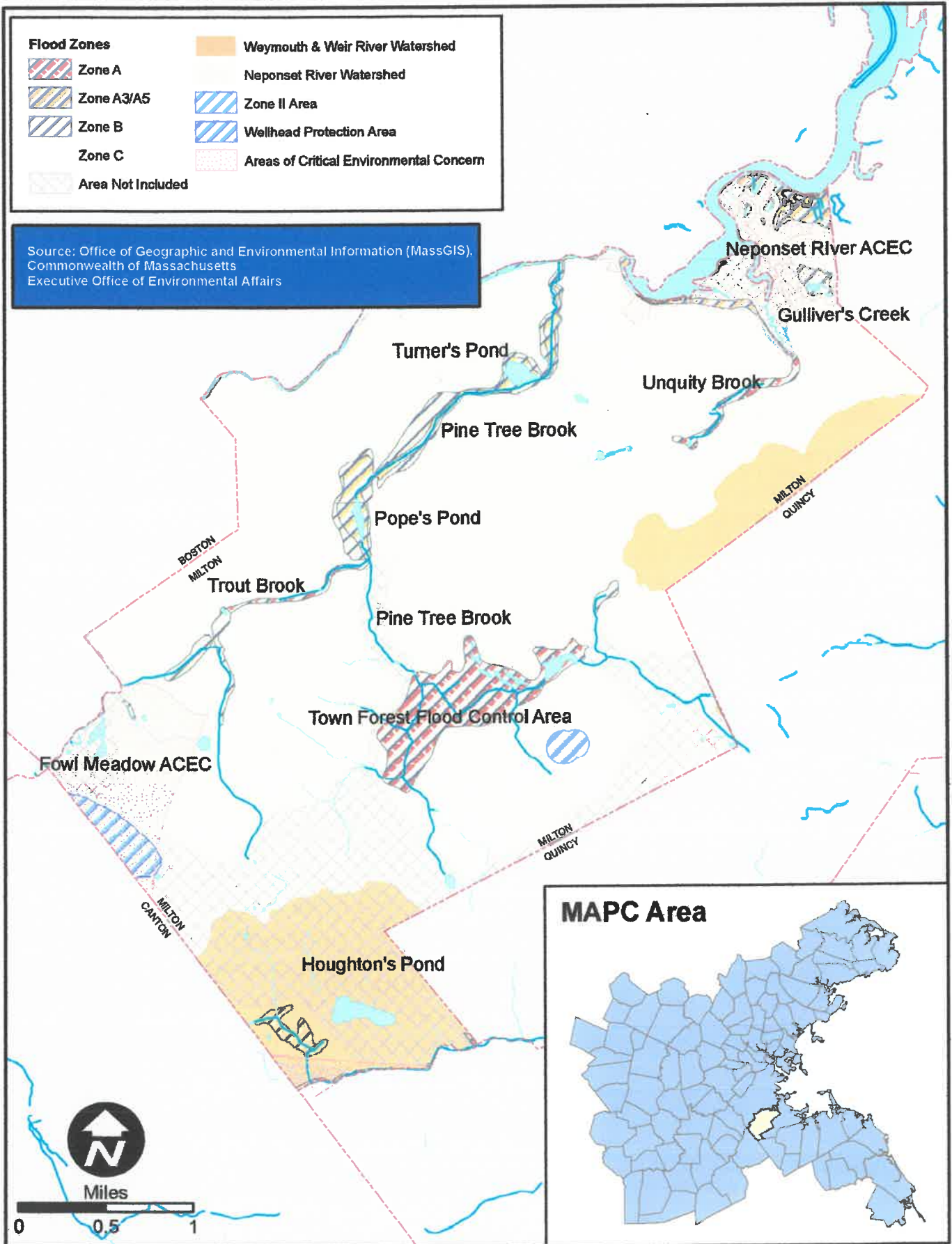

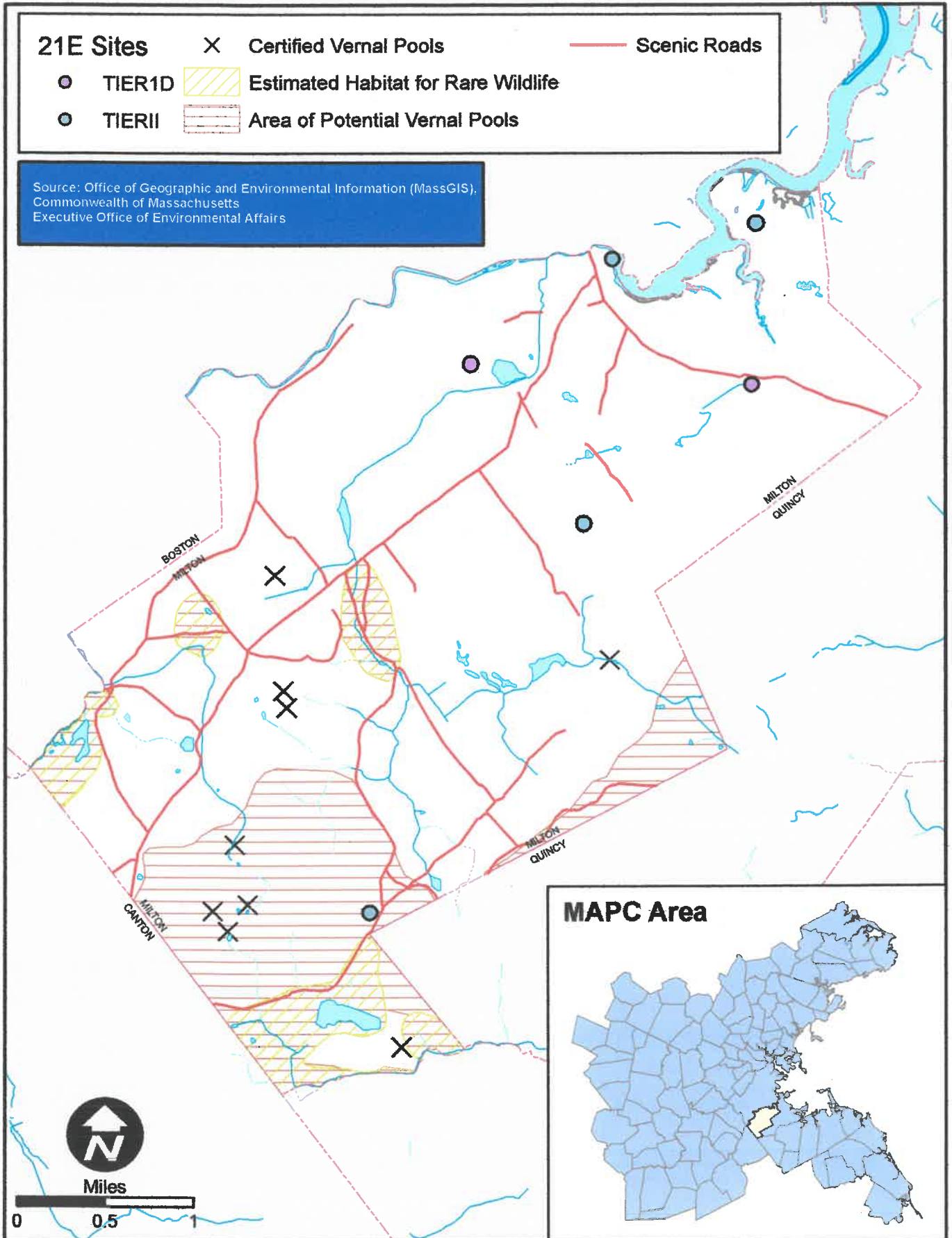

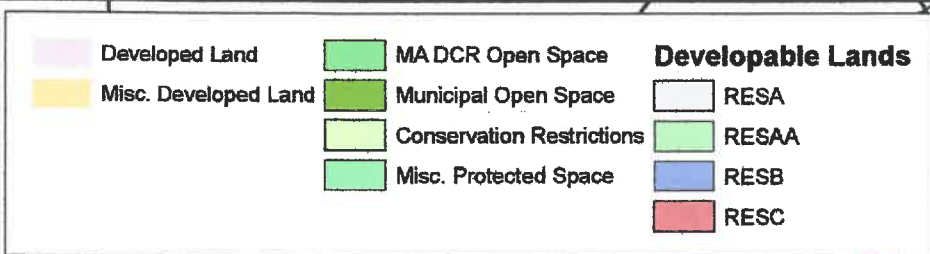

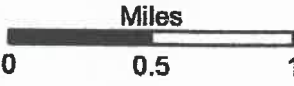

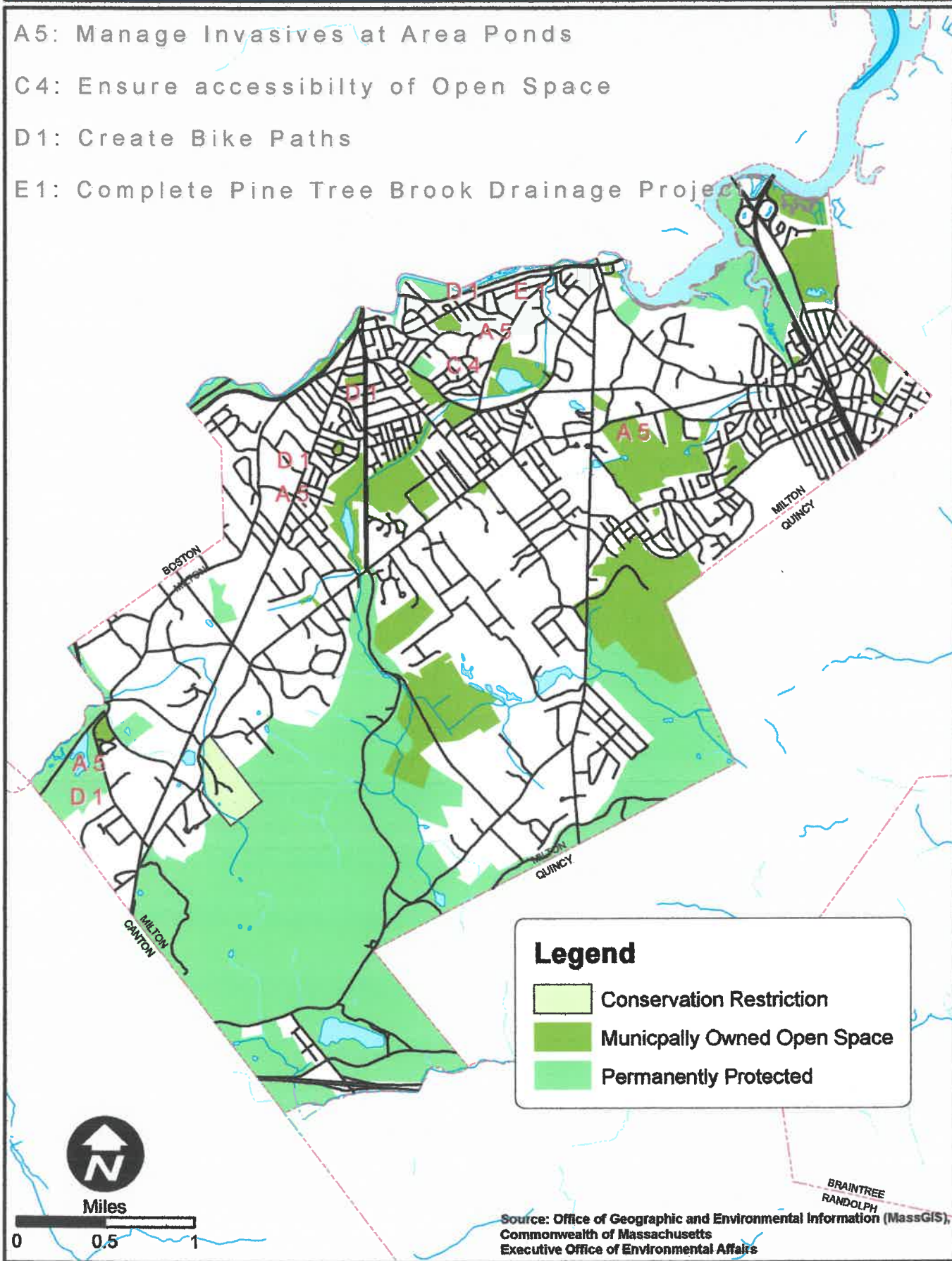
Map 7: Five Year Action Plan
